



ALMOST FAMOUS méthode champenoise

MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA 2021

100% GRÜNER VELTLINER, BRUT

It's fragrance is quite classic: lemon pith and a hint of orange blossom. This vintage's charismatic palate goes further, suggesting jicama, celery stalk, soda bread and lime, with a great deal of minerality that extends through the finish. Expect an acidity so high and bright, it prickles.















ALPINE WHITE 2023


2022 VINTAGE, 100% ESTATE GROWN, LIVERMORE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

It's a white blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Albariño, and Grüner Veltliner.

It's captivating aromatic play of pomelo, peach blossom, and pink guava. The wine's fruit character is perfectly balanced with its acidity, leading to a long beeswax finish.

BLACKBERRY PIE, DRIED CRANBERRY AND FIG, JOINED BY STAR
ANISE AND CHAI SPICE. ON THE MIDPALATE, FURTHER
RECALLING NUT HUSK, DRIED BLACK FRUIT, CEDAR AND ROOT
BEER. THESE NOTES THRUM THROUGH THE FINISH,
OSCILLATING BETWEEN DARK FRUIT, COCOA AND HAZELNUT.

















JACE CABERNET FRANC 2023 family owned estate Grown

THE 2023 CABERNET FRANC HAILS FROM OUR NEWEST VINEYARD, TENDED CAREFULLY BY THE LEMMONS FAMILY, AND ADJACENT TO OUR ACCLAIMED TRISKA VINEYARD. IT SHARES THE SAME COOL, PACIFIC-INFLUENCED MICROCLIMATE AND GRAVELLY SOILS. INKY HUED, THIS VINTAGE IS FRUIT DRIVEN, WITH A NOSE SUGGESTING DARK BLACK CHERRY AND GARDEN HERBS. ON THE PALATE, AMPLE TANNINS, PEPPERCORN AND BAY LEAF COMPLEMENT THE BLACK FRUIT FLAVORS.
