TASTING NOTE

Petit Verdot is a beautiful varietal that can be challenging to ripen in the vineyard. But it is always a ringer and wildly complex in the best years. Plum, blackberry, cranberry, fig, violet, anise, leather, cured meat, black pepper, eucalyptus (deep audible breath in), cocoa, coffee, bay leaf, grape swisher cigarillo. The list could go on and on with all of the fantastic aromatics that burst out of the glass. The wine is full and hits every part of your palate. Tannins are robust but not too aggressive, allowing this to be enjoyed youthfully. And most importantly, it leaves you drooling from the natural acid present in the wine. Dag nabbit, we've done it again.
