TASTING NOTE

Picture a playful concoction where brandied cherries and boysenberry team up with baking spices, dried florals, and a hint of fennel, throwing a flavor fiesta that even includes a cool Rhubarb Pie vibe. As the fruity parade settles on your palate, you're greeted by the subtle embrace of fine-grain tannins, mingling with espresso grounds, baking spice, and a dash of vanilla. Meanwhile, intense black fruit aromas command the stage, with blackcurrant, blackberry, and plum leading the show, flaunting the classic profile of this grape. And just when you think it can't get any better, in sneak those sneaky hints of cedar and vanilla from French oak barrels, adding depth and complexity like secret ingredients in a recipe for deliciousness. It's like a whimsical carnival ride for your taste buds, with each sip offering a delightful surprise at every turn. Decant before opening; will drink its best in 5-6 years.
