This Pinot Noir comes from the Kent family's north-facing Triska Vineyard, the coolest site in Crane Ridge which experiences constant breezes and a thick blanket of coastal fog each morning.

The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard, combined with Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking, creates a wine that reflects our true-to-terroir winemaking philosophy, only enhanced by eight months in French oak cooperage prized by Burgundian producers.

Darcie Kent donates proceeds of each bottle sold to the East Bay Regional Parks District.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE BY JULIAN HALASZ

Aromas of fresh raspberry, cranberry, and nutmeg intertwine with flavors of ripe red plum and cherry compote. This soft, juicy Pinot Noir features subtle tannins with a hint of incense.
