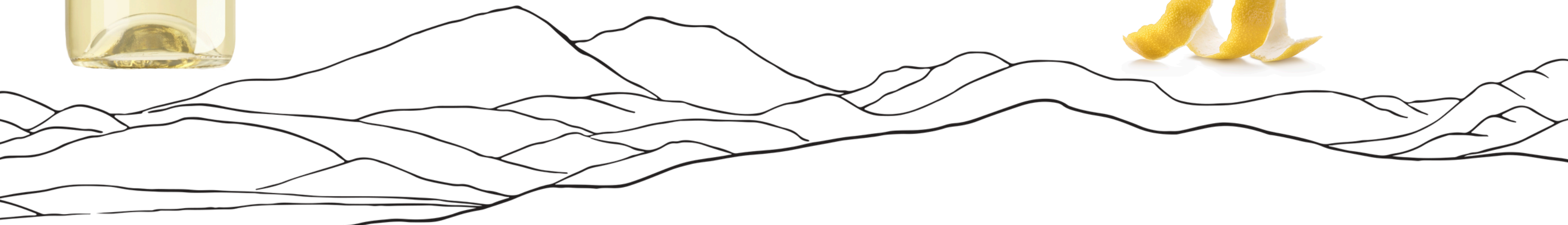

**Darcie and her family believe in creating a perfect match between terroir and varietal. Working side by side with their neighbors Tom and Paige Lemmons, Darcie and her family planted the site with the uncommon “musque” clone of Sauvignon Blanc, which is very expressive and creates wines with a hint of White grapefruit, gooseberry and jalapeño, with bright acidity, soft body, and lemon zest finish.**

DARCIE AND HER FAMILY BELIEVE IN CREATING A PERFECT MATCH BETWEEN TERROIR AND VARIETAL. WORKING SIDE BY SIDE WITH THEIR NEIGHBORS MARK AND MARIA TRISKA, DARCIE AND HER FAMILY PLANTED THE SITE WITH CHARDONNAY. THE COMBINATION OF WELL DRAINING SOILS, SUNNY DAYS AND HIGH WINDS ENHANCE ITS ACIDITY AND DELICACY OF YELLOW AND GREEN APPLES, HONEYSUCKLE, AND A HINT OF FRESH SOURDOUGH BREAD FROM ITS CREAMY LEES INFLUENCE.

THE TRISKA VINEYARD IS ONE OF THE KENT FAMILY'S ESTATE VINEYARDS, AND IS A UNIQUE MICROCLIMATE: IT IS CONSISTENTLY A FEW DEGREES COOLER THAN THE NEIGHBORING SITES, AND RUNS ALONG AN ARROYO THAT ATTRACTS FOGS AND BRISK, COASTAL BREEZES LONGER THAN NEIGHBORING BLOCKS.

THE KENT FAMILY'S GENTLE ATTENTION TO DETAIL IN THE VINEYARD, COMBINED WITH JULIAN HALASZ'S MASTERFUL WINEMAKING, CREATES A WINE THAT REFLECTS OUR TRUE-TO-TERROIR WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY.

### TASTING NOTE

PRONOUNCED MINERALITY IN THE AROMA, PALATE AND FINISH, COMPLEMENTED BY NOTES OF ASIAN PEAR, APPLE BLOSSOM AND WHITE PEPPERCORN. A FEATHERY TOUCH OF TANNINS AND A GENEROUS MID-PALATE MAKES THIS WINE PAIRABLE WITH THE TOUGHEST DISHES, LIKE SPICY STIR FRIES.

## “NOIR” PINOT NOIR 2023

LIVERMORE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

THE 2023 OPENS WITH A BURST OF DRIED RED CHERRY, CRANBERRY, LICORICE TEA, CINNAMON AND PECAN BRITTLE. THESE NOTES COME INTO EVEN SHARPER RELIEF ON THE PALATE, WHERE BRIGHT RED PLUM AND CASSIS NOTES FOREGROUNDS THE EARTHIER INFLUENCE OF THE PINOT NOIR, WHICH CONTRIBUTES HYSSOP, MALLOW, AND ELDER BARK. THE WINE'S BODY HAS AN ALMOST VELVETEEN TEXTURE, WITH A STRONG CORE OF ACIDITY AND GRIPPY TANNINS.

## STONE PATCH CABERNET FRANC 2022



This block of Cabernet Franc vines lies along a fault line, and is known for the quartz-rich boulders that percolate up through the soil. The 2022 vintage includes a small amount of Malbec grown in the ancestral field blend style from the same small block.

Integrated aromas of pie cherry, nutmeg, and "Livermore Valley garrigue," reminiscent of the sage brush and grasses of our growing region. You can also find suggestions of raspberry, juniper and mocha. This continues through the bone dry palate, where hints of Turkish coffee, bay leaf, and blackcurrant lead into a black cherry finish. A trifecta of high acidity, tannins and silty texture point to great cellar-worthiness.







LONE HILL VINEYARD

WEST HILL

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2022



**The east and west side of Lone Hill are each a little different, with the fruit on the west side containing more pyrazines than any other Cab grown on the estate. Pyrazines are what make a 'sauvignon "savage," creating peppery and spicy notes.**

**100% of the grapes were estate grown. The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard is matched by Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking.**

**Opulent aromas of juicy black fruit, like a molten blueberry in a just-baked muffin, collide with notes of red pepper flake, white peppercorn, tobacco and silvermint. The palate is equally charismatic, with technicolor notes of black cherry, cocoa, kola nut, coriander and nutmeg all vying for attention. Bristling and spicy tannins frame the wine's soft layered body and backbone of acidity. Cellar through 2038 to unlock this wine's full potential.**
