SINGLE VINEYARD **CABERNET SAUVIGNON**VINTAGE 2020

Dried black cherry, fruit leather, licorice and mulling spice curl up from the glass. Spicy tannins cling to your gums, and there's a hint of sarsaparilla on the finish.

This wine could be considered a field blendit contains 15% Petite Sirah from the same vineyard, which makes it dark and inky!

Blackberry, spicy tamarind and dark chocolate ganache mix with a touch of sagebrush, lilac and silver mint. Equal parts high acidity, piquant tannins and velvety body, with a lingering savory finish.
